Some of the main events of the year 2004



ANNIVERSARY

- A reason to celebrate in Gjirokastër. Together with the 10th anniversary of the church, the newly renovated chapel was inaugurated. Because of the large number of people who had come to celebrate with us, the celebration was done outside under a tent.



ENVIRONMENT DAY

- Under the care of the Minister of the environment an Environment Day was organized at the Nehemia Center in Buçimas, where different ministers and personalities of public life took part. New buildings with the modern energy concept presented the perfect frame for the different speeches which were about the alternative sources for a constant supply of energy and a better environment.

BRANCHES; PARTNERS & FRIENDS

The Nehemia Foundation in Albania is growing

In the year 2004 we have started another branch in Krume, Has. The "Golden Cross Ministry" is a new partner of the Nehemia Foundation. In the USA. We have created contacts with the GBA (Global Business Assistance). We also work together closely with SFI (Swiss Foundation International) in Tirana.

- Administration needs structure. For a constant and healthy growth of an organization, clear structure and a qualified management are needed. For this reason we have worked for the "NEHEMIA MANUAL" - a compendium of internal regulations and working instructions. The manual is the product of many years of experience in Albania and intensive counselling with successful managers and leaders of other missions. A first step toward quality management. (QM)

HIGHSCHOOL

- The Nehemia highschool begins its first year. The oldest students of the Nehemia school continue with the first year of highschool. Even though we had much difficulty in receiving the proper license, just a little before the beginning of the school year, the green light was given from the Ministry of Education.



200 families isolated from snow.

In January 2005, the local emergency staff asked us to help with food in a few villages in the district of Pogradec, which were isolated from the snow. Over just a short period of time we managed to gather and transport over 8.6 tons of food.

Medical service

MEDICAL SERVICE



Individual social and medical services are becoming more necessary.

We are hearing of more and more instances of the elderly who have been forsaken and of people with handicaps that need help. For them we organize home visits and help for their families. Besides material care, spiritual care and prayer, medical care and physiotherapy are also often necessary. At the moment the state cannot offer these services.

Nurses' assistant

In May the second course for nurses' assistant, which is organized by MNA to come to the aid of both physically and mentally handicapped people, will end. We hope that all six students that finish the course will be able to be employed in our social services. MNA will soon make possible the functioning of an orthopaedic workshop .

ORTHOPAEDIC TECHNIC

PHYSIOTHERAPY

Even in the north of Albania there is a lot to do. The desire of our coworkers in Has is to open a physiotherapy clinic in Krume.

FIRST AID SERVICE & CONTINGENCY PLANS

There have been many discussions about first aid, search & rescue and civil protection. We are working together with the „Swiss Foundation International“ (SFI) and the Ministry of Health for a First Aid concept in the whole country. The first step at Nehemia will be the building of a small emergency clinic, where medical training will also be given.

We need more premises!

Our Nehemia school has an urgent need for another building for the highschool. For this there is need of necessary finances.

ACCOMMODATION

In Bucimas the building of a new guest home has been planned.

CHURCH BUILDING PROJECT

The building of some new centres such as the Nehemia church in Gjirokaster and a new center for the Apostolic Church (Nehemia partner) in the village of Stropkë has also been planned.

Medical Emergency Aid Albania (MNA)

MNA is our partner for all the

here the spiritual and material
help for many other distant
villages in this zone is
coordinated. CHW works
closely together with the
United Methodist Church.

Global Business Assistance (GBA)

In the year 2004 we began
working closely together with
the American missionary
organization "Global Business
Assistance". GBA supports
different projects.

BRANCHES

BUÇIMAS (BC)

Here is where the center of the
Nehemia Foundation is. In the
new building complex is where a
large number of projects are
done, including the Nehemia
school. Guests and coworkers
will find a warm welcome in the
mission house.

POGRADEC (PG)

Only about 2 miles away from
Bucimas, on the side of the
wonderful lake of Ohrid, is the
Nehemia center, Pogradec. A
large number of church activities
are done here as well as
different projects in the social
field, kindergarten and the
Nehemia youth center.

GJIROKASTËR (GJ)

In this southern city another work
branch of the Nehemia
Foundation is located, where,
besides the intensive church
services, different social projects
come to the aid of hundreds of
people, such as the soup kitchen
for the poor, and mobile help in
their families.

DURRËS (DR)

In the large seashore city,
Nehemia cares mainly for the
members of the large community
of gypsies, and for the poor in
the surrounding villages. Besides
the many regular meetings,
humanitarian aid is also offered,
as well as day car for children.

HAS (HS)

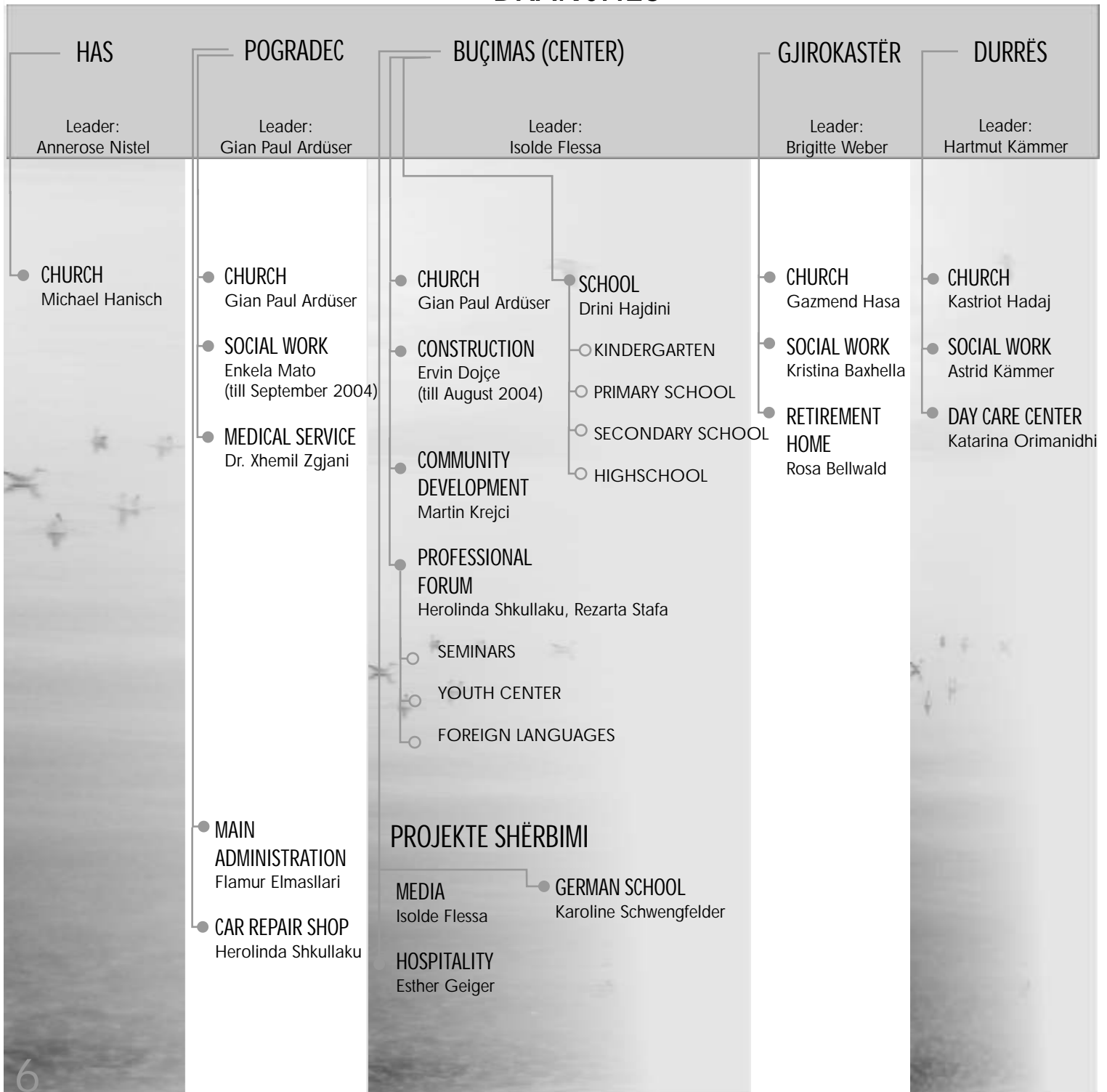
This is the newest branch of the

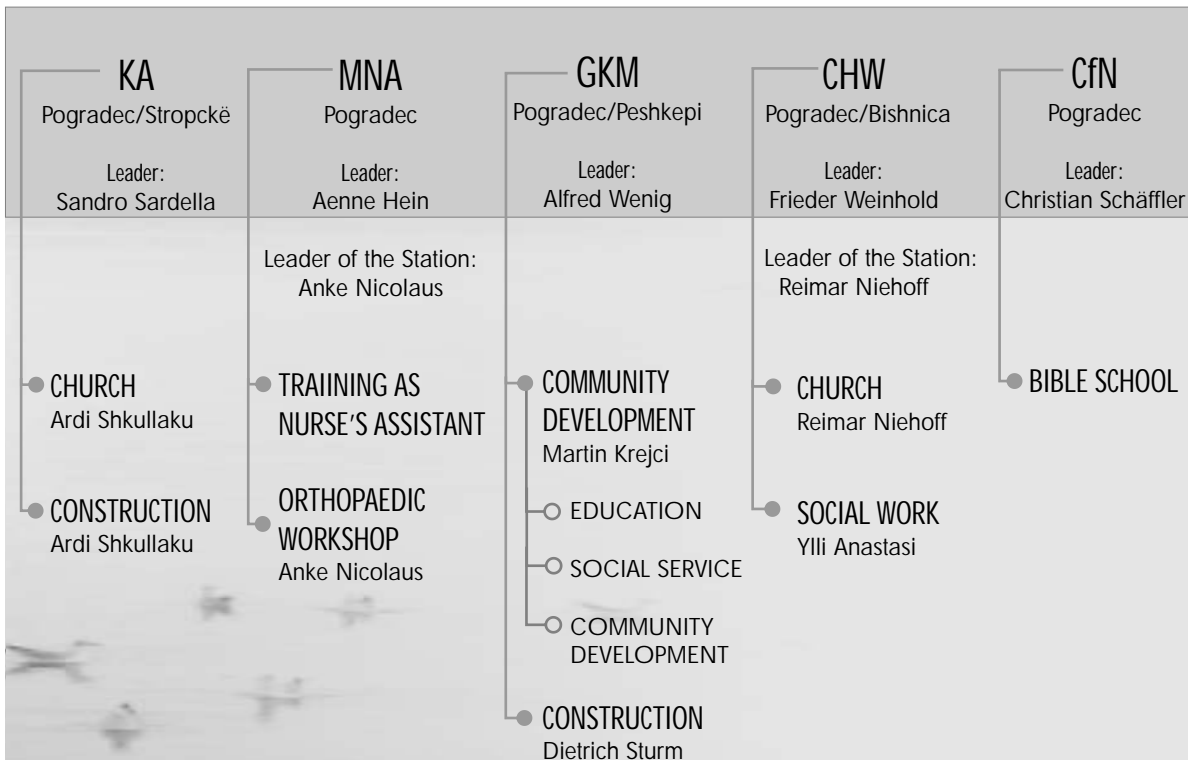

The responsible use of the donations is our rule.

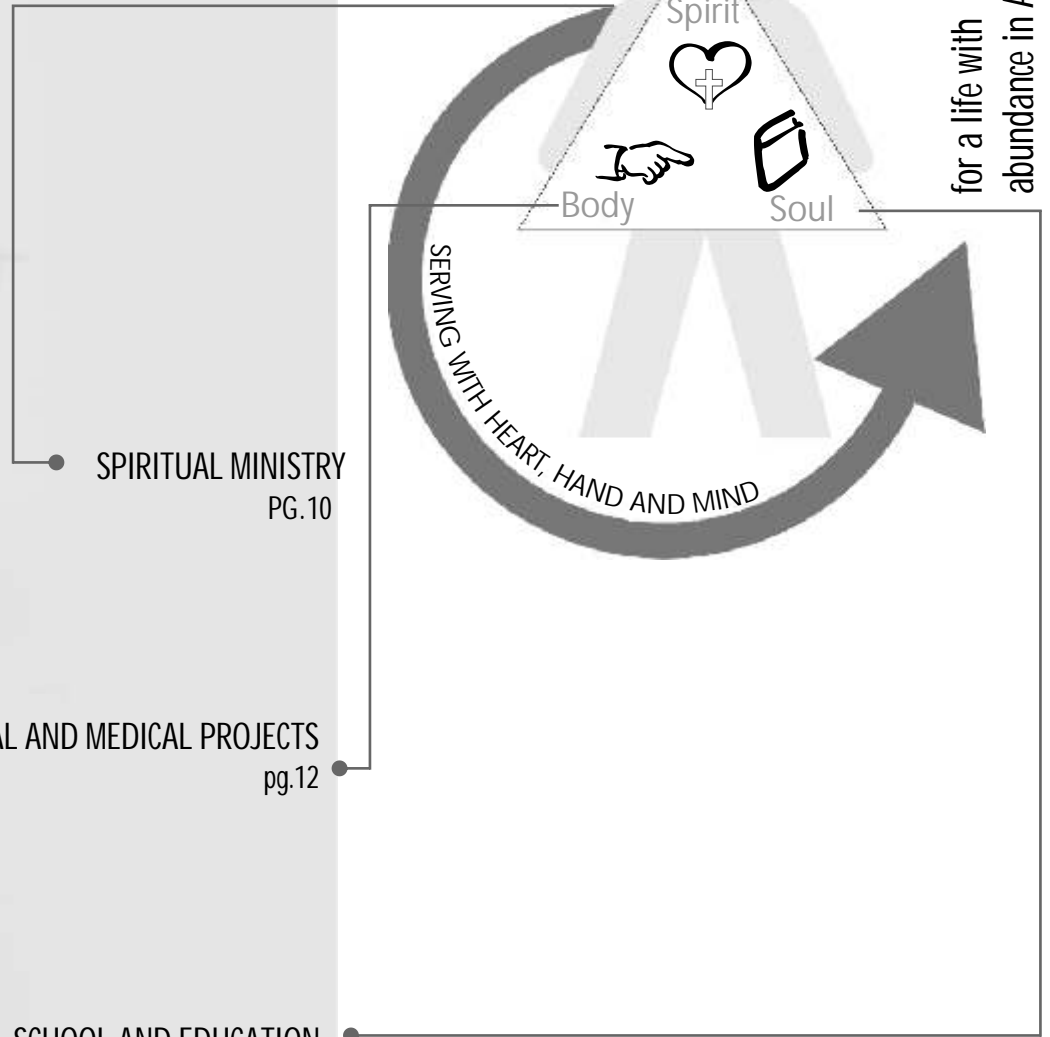
We put the emphasis on:

S P I R I T U A L M I N I S T R Y

Missionary work is the base of our activities.

Born from the desire of many Christians to serve this place, the humanitarian work of the Nehemia Foundation is based upon biblical bases.

The founders of this humanitarian organization and many of its co-workers are dedicated Christians, even the financial sources come in the largest part from donations which are given as contributions for the development of the place according to biblical values.

He who is himself blessed wants to also bless others. For this reason the work of the Nehemia Foundation in Albania is closely tied together with church planting, spiritual counselling and prayer.

The Nehemia foundation is part of the international Pentecostal movement and in Albania is a member of the Evangelical Alliance (VUSH). As a protestant church, our doctrinal base is the Bible.

LITERATURE AND MEDIA



● Theoretical and practical formation are pillars in our spiritual work. That is why Nehemia, besides the preaching services in the church, also offers many seminars with different themes. Some examples from last year:

- Spiritual leadership (Jürgen Kleinsorge)
- Family and education of children (Eberhard + Claudia Mühlen)
- The work with home groups
- The world wide mission (Both with pastor Stefan Ross)
- Seminars about worship (Udo Knöfel)

● The Bible school in Pogradec offers intensive training for young christians.

The school is a project of the partner organization of the Nehemia Foundation "Christ for the Nations". Last year nine students finished a one year training. Another group of five students, two of which are from Kosova, will finish the Bible school course in April. Besides the leaders of the school a number of spiritual leaders from Albania and Germany also give lessons. During the training the students live in the school. Included in the curriculum there are also practice in the church, leading the children's meeting, small groups, prayer meetings and evangelisations, as well as practical voluntary work in the program of the Bible School.

● Literature and different media are an essential part of an effective spiritual work.

For this reason the printing and distribution of books, cassettes, and videocassettes is one of the spiritual works of the Nehemia Foundation.

For example:

- Translation of 50 preachings of Derek Prince on tape (DR)
- Audio tapes with biblical teachings (CfN)
- Filming of seminars
- Translation and preparation for printing of books
- The distribution of literature

● The main part of our spiritual ministry is the work in the local churches.

Here is included evangelisation and services in the church, home groups, prayer, spiritual counselling and training, but also relief and aid projects for other people in the form of home visits and helping the poor.

In 64 villages and cities regular activities take place. Around 600 grown-ups and 1400 children come regularly to the different meetings

Last year 58 people were baptised and became part of the local churches

Last year a special importance in the church work was given to the cell work. In many churches groups of believers are formed that meet regularly to pray together, to study the bible and to talk with each-other.

There have been organized various activities. Besides the many concerts and evangelisations, among others also with Walter Heidenreich from Lüdenscheid and the musical band TNT from Sohland, there has been organized a wide range of conferences, summer national and international camps for grown-ups as well as children, and also the yearly distribution of thousands of Christmas packages for children in the church and school.

M E D I C A L & S O C I A L H E L P

Our call is to help

In the Nehemia Foundation there exist a large number of projects in the field of social work, development help and medical services.

We show care for difficult cases where the state does not have the means to contribute. The help that we offer lies in a great variety of fields.

In order for our limited sources to come to the aid of as many people as possible, we try to work with maximum efficiency. We care for the logistics and qualifications of our co-workers, and coordinate the various services offered by Nehemia, the Nehemia partners and the authorities.

HELP FOR THE VILLAGES

HELP FOR THE AUTHORITIES AND INSTITUTIONS



HUMANITARIAN HELP FOR FAMILIES



● **Community development** means the concept of help in all aspects of village life. In close co-operation with the organization "Golden Cross Ministry" a group of projects have been started in the village of Peshkepi whose goal is to give the villagers a perspective for the future. Here is included: Building projects like the building and renovation of the school (2003), the building of the mission house (04/05) or the planned rebuilding of the house of culture. To make possible the renovation of the infrastructure, exact measurements of the territory of the village have been made. Soon the planting of trees will begin. In the new school many chances for qualifications and training will be offered, from computer training, music lessons, English and German courses till the sewing lessons. We also organize meetings for children and home groups. The mobile care service regularly visits four families.

In Bishnicë a tree nursery has been created. 2000 trees have been planted which later will be given the farmers of this region. (CHW)

● **Help for people in need** Unemployment, sicknesses or tragedies are the reasons for many causes of bitter poverty which cannot be covered by the public social network. We help in these instances by food, clothing and other humanitarian aid. The sick have received financial aid for operations and costly treatments. Destroyed houses have been repaired and in December 2005, by the request of the local emergency staff, we helped with food more than 200 families in the villages isolated from snow.

In 2004 more than 1,900 families received material aid and/or financial aid.

Food every day

In Gjirokastër and in Pogradec altogether 40 people receive every day a warm meal and also from time to time humanitarian aid and clothing. If they want they can take part in the additional meetings and celebrations that are offered by Nehemia. The participants of this program are children from very poor families, orphans and old and forsaken elderly people.

For a fulfilled evening of life

The co-workers of the Nehemia foundation in Gjirokastër have cared for many years for the welfare of the people in the state retirement home. This work has problems from the constant lack of personnel and financial sources. Last year the kitchen of this retirement home was supported every month with around 400 € for the purchase of fresh vegetables and other food products. Besides this the Nehemia Foundation also pays the salary for a guard and assistant. Around 50 elderly are especially grateful for the care, visits, spiritual counselling, regular services and the excursions organized by Nehemia.

The authorities and organizations are grateful for support

Here it is worthy to mention the work in the high security prisons in Tepelenë (GJ) and Tiranë (CHW), with visits and distribution of humanitarian materials and aid. Other aid:

- Distribution of furniture and materials for more than 22 public schools
- Vehicles (on loan) for public offices
- 3 X-ray equipments for hospitals
- Bus (on loan) for a priv. school
- Renovation of a kindergarten (GBA)
- Office equipment for the local authorities administrations etc.

All of the medical projects are realized in cooperation with MNA (Medical Emergency Aid Albania), a partner organization of the Nehemia Foundation.



Training according to German standards

Medical care for people with handicaps, both physical and mental, is a very challenging field of work, which in Albania does not exist yet as a recognized profession. Thus the need for home care is very great.

The partner organization of the Nehemia Foundation, MNA, offers special training in this direction. Girls, women or boys with no work have a chance to finish a one year course and in the end they submit to a test according to German standards. The lessons are given by German nurses and specialists in the proper fields. This training is financed by the "Diakonisches Werk" in Germany.

In the end of June 2004 three students finished the course with success, and today they work full time in the care services offered from the Nehemia Foundation. In the second course, in progress, again three students take part who, if possible, shall also be employed by the Nehemia Foundation.

More than just crutches

Orthopaedic workshops are almost unknown in Albania, and yet the need for artificial limbs is great. For this reason MNA has built in Pogradec a orthopaedic workshop which should begin working in the year 2005. But unfortunately it has still not been possible to receive the license. The goal is that not only to offer practical care for the individual, but also to prepare orthopaedic mechanics in the country.

The emergency rescue service

In the future we want to do more in the field of emergency rescue. The goal is the development of a national concept of search and rescue in cooperation with the Ministry of Health, with whom we had many talks and developed initial plans. Till now there exists an emergency service and visits from doctors in Bishnicë and in the surrounding villages. (CHW)

Integral care in Pogradec, Gjirokastër and Bishnicë

The care services and the home visits from the Nehemia Foundation are done there where the need is greatest: to the people with handicaps, to the forsaken elderly, and to bedridden patients especially in poor families. For these cases there is no support available from the social system in Albania. That's why the people in need are depending on help from us. We help individually through: psychotherapy treatment of wounds, with food and humanitarian aid, practical help in the house work, and naturally also spiritual support and prayer. 27 patients in the Pogradec district are visited regularly and receive care. In Gjirokastër six elderly ladies who live by themselves receive practical help; and in the village Bishnicë CHW offers care for 10 patients. Most of the co-workers of the care service have finished the course of our partner organization MNA for training as nurse's assistant.

Doctors in action

In the outpatient clinic in Pogradec a paediatrician cares for the medical treatment and surveys of the students in the Nehemia school. He is also the responsible contact partner for medical treatment by our home care services.

Also this year teams of German and Albanian dentists visited and treated the students in the Nehemia school, the students in the public schools in Bishnicë and the children in a children's home in Tirana (SFI). The teaching of dental hygiene is also very important and has good results. In comparison with the students of other schools in this zone, the students of the Nehemia school have much healthier teeth.

SCHOOL & EDUCATION

School for life

A good education is the ideal condition for a successful future, for the individual as well as for all the society.

It is very important to transmit not only knowledge and ability but also a solid base of values and the formation of character. This is an important goal in the educational work at Nehemia.

For this reason there exist at Nehemia different possibilities of education. Old or young, poor or rich, we want to give everyone a chance to receive a qualified education.

● A start toward a successful future

From primary school to high school Nehemia is offering an all-inclusive education for children. For the moment 320 children attend the school in Bucimas/Pogradec. The lessons are based on the public school program in Albania. Besides this, additional courses are offered, starting from foreign languages and computer lessons, till the art, music and sport and many other courses. The running costs of the school are covered mainly by the tuition.

Several chronically ill children attend this school because here they find a safe environment and a special care.

For the coming year it is planned that a special emphasis is put on the practical training. In this program electro-technics and carpentry make up a part as well as sewing and gardening. The idea for this concept we got from a German school, the Landheim Schondorf /Ammersee, our future partners.

Our goal is the recognition of the graduates of the Nehemia school in Germany. For this a lot must still be done in the coming year.

● Learning from the beginning

39 children attend the Nehemia kindergarten in Pogradec. The number of registrations is much larger than the number of free places. This shows how much the parents in Pogradec value what this kindergarten offers: Pleasant, and safe premises and good meals and experienced teachers who care lovingly for the little ones. For a child with handicaps we hired a special teacher who cares especially for him.

● A chance for those who have no chance

The day care center in Nishtulla, Durrës, was created especially for forsaken children of the Gypsy population. Regular attendance of school is almost impossible for these children, even though by law they are required to finish school. This phenomena has many reasons, reasons for which we are trying to give a solution. Beginning from homework assistance, remedial lessons, teachings in hygiene and healthy meals everyday, these children receive an intensive care. Safety on the road to school and regular contact with the appropriate teachers in the public schools open the door to these children for a regular school education. For the moment 46 children of different ages attend the day care center, some of whom have gradually become the best in their classes.

● The road to school

For many children from the remote mountain villages, the nearest school is a few hours away by foot. In the winter they have to pass through snow with depth of more than one metre. In order to make a normal school education for these children possible, our partner organization CHW in Bishnicë offers a dormitory, where not only shelter and food are offered but also an intensive care. For the moment there are 12 children that live in the two apartments in Bishnicë.

- Lessons from rich treasures of experience
Nehemia regularly invites qualified speakers, many of them known specialists in their fields. Qualification is a necessity for the co-workers of the Nehemia foundation, but besides that trainings are offered also for other organizations and private persons.

Special importance is given to the qualification of our teachers.

For the teachers we are offering continuous qualifications by trainers from Albania and abroad; among others the leaders of the Pedagogic Institute in Tirana (Prof. Dr. Marjana Sinani and Prof. Dr. Milika Dhamo), and also the "Power Management Team" from Holland.

Valuable for parents and teachers is the educational counselling through Claudia and Eberhard Mühlen.

Discovery of talents and professional formation

It is not only the youth that take part in the courses of the Youth Center in Pogradec. The favorite courses are sewing and hairdressing. This is also because these courses are acknowledged by the Ministry of work.

With a mobile studio of laptop computers we are able to offer training also in villages. Even during frequent cases of power failure.

Foreign languages: a window into the outside world

As an organization with its roots in Europe we are aware of the value of foreign languages that make knowledge and experience from the whole world accessible.

The Nehemia foundation offers German and English courses, not only for its co-workers, but also in courses of the youth center and in villages.

Our German teachers are working also in the translation of texts, books, and seminars.



C O N S T R U C T I O N

MISSION HOUSE PESHKËPI (GKM)

in Peshkëpi
In the village Peshkëpi, in continuation of the community development project, the building of a mission house has begun, that offers premises for an ambulance, housing for co-workers, and also offers a place for church activities. The end of these buildings is planned for the summer of 2005.

CHURCH IN STROPCKE (KA)

In the future the renovation of the community centre has been planned, as well as the renovation of the village's infrastructure.

CHURCH (GJ)

GUEST HOUSE (GKM)



In Stropckë the Apostolic Church has begun with the first preparations for the building of a social centre and a church according to the model of the church in Buçimas. Till now the surrounding wall has been built as well as a preliminary premise for meetings.

in Gjirokaštër
In June 2004 the inauguration of the newly renovated center for the church in Gjirokaštër was held. Next year the surrounding wall and a soup kitchen for the poor will be built. In the meantime the planning continues for a new large centre for the church as well as for various social services.

in Buçimas
In the summer of 2005 in Buçimas the reconstruction of the guest house should begin. Till now several containers have been placed that will serve as workshops and storage places for the construction as well as the craftsmen training. Later the workshops will be transferred into buildings that will be built for this purpose.

After the fire on the roof of the school in Buçimas great repairs were needed, above all for the solar panels.
